- ✎ Personal saving



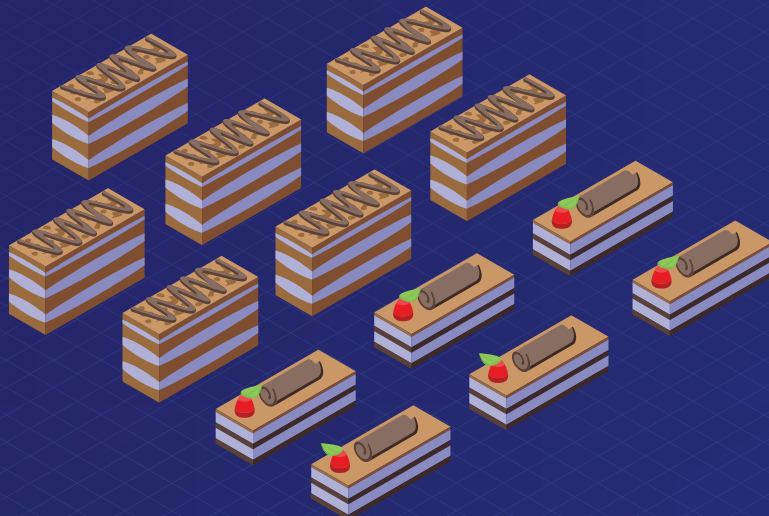

Statistics for a detailed view of the interrelationships between U.S. producers and users and the contribution to production across industries

Regional

Statistics that look at the geographic distribution of U.S. economic activity and growth, with a consistent framework for analyzing and comparing individual state and local area economies

- ✎ GDP and personal income by state
- ✎ GDP and personal income by county, metro, and other areas
- ✎ Regional price parities by state and metro area
- ✎ Consumer spending by state

Statistics that focus on economic transactions with other countries including measuring the value of U.S. international assets and liabilities and direct investment by multinational enterprises

- ✎ International transactions
- ✎ Trade in goods and services
- ✎ International investment position
- ✎ Direct investment by country and industry
